

Abstract	Islamic criminal law is one of the important fields of fiqh in Islamic jurisprudence. Islamic criminal law began to take shape in the very first years of the Muslim community during the lifetime of the Prophet Muhammad, and as Islam, unlike other religions, quickly became the state religion of the Arab caliphate of the Ottoman Empire, Iran, and the need for a comprehensive, sustainable justice system. The uniqueness of Islam as a religion and ideology is that it encompasses any sphere of human life, reaching into every human action. What is not in the revelation of God or in the Qur'an is filled with the explanations (hadiths) of the Prophet Muhammad (pbuh), based on the sayings of the Shiites as well as the sayings of the righteous Caliph Ali. And what is not described in the holy books can be supplemented by the joint decisions of the authoritative theological scholars and the analogies made in various Islamic schools. Thus, a Muslim judge has a wide range of choices to make. Due to the confessional nature of the population, Islamic law is now fully or partially enforced in many countries of the world or in some regions of some countries. During the reign of George V in Georgia, Demeter Tbilisi, along with his three spiritual brothers, the Italian Franciscan monks, sent a holy throne on a diplomatic mission to the Mongolian Kaen. In April 1321, all four Franciscan missionaries on their way to China, in the Indian city of Tan, were captured and tortured to death for their devotion to Christianity. Almost nothing is known about Demetrius Tbilisi in our country, while it is the seven centuries since their martyrdom day in the cities of northern Italy every year. Marked with liturgy. The Bishop of the Indian city of Mumbai (Bombay) also celebrates the day of the martyrdom of four martyrs of the Franciscan monk. This year, on the occasion of the anniversary, the 700th anniversary of the martyrdom of Demetrius Tbilisi and his spiritual brothers was celebrated by the decision of the Bishop of the Local Catholic Church of Georgia, together with the Catholic priests of Italy and India. In the Catholic cathedrals of all three countries, a documentary about these four martyrs was shown in Italy before the solemn service, with the martyrs “. The icon of Demetre Tbilisi was specially written, which he traveled to the Catholic Councils of Georgia throughout the year. In addition to the religious-pastoral workload, from a secular perspective, the mission of Demeter Tbilisi and his spiritual brothers is a clear example of the common Georgian-European common interests and cooperation of the Middle Ages, as well as in that decade, (1329.), George the Magnificent's transfer from Smyrne to Tbilisi to the Episcopal Cathedral of the Catholic Church. The martyrdom of Demetrius Tbilisi made a significant contribution to the establishment of benevolent relations between the Holy See and the Kingdom of Georgia.

Abstract	The article discusses the stages of the formation of Islamic military law. Considering the historical facts, as well as the requirements given in the Qur'an and the Sun, the historical-religious events that influenced the formation of Islamic military law are analyzed. Beginning in the first years of the Hijri, Islamic leaders have been reluctant to treat their armed followers within the legal framework. Muhammad the pre-emptive, and then the righteous caliphs, attached great importance to the formation of the Muslim army, the ethical, hygienic, and lawful conduct of warriors. The main role in this difficult, contradictory process was to develop military norms and perform uninterrupted performance. The first military statutes literally determined the strength and further success of the Muslim army. The military norms established in the 7th century, the forms of war production, the demands on warriors, the rules of war and the establishment of peace are largely relevant today.
